- 1. A public school employee in that school system;
- 2. AN INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR WHO SUPERVISES OR WORKS DIRECTLY WITH STUDENTS IN THAT SCHOOL SYSTEM; OR
- 3. AN EMPLOYEE OF AN INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR, INCLUDING A BUS DRIVER OR BUS ASSISTANT, WHO SUPERVISES OR WORKS DIRECTLY WITH STUDENTS IN THAT SCHOOL SYSTEM, or

(viii) To the director of a licensed child care facility or licensed child placement agency for the purpose of carrying out appropriate personnel actions following a report of suspected child neglect or abuse alleged to have been committed by an employee of the facility or agency and involving a child who is currently or who was previously under that facility's or agency's care.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2001.

## CHAPTER 313

(House Bill 1242)

AN ACT concerning

## State Commission on Kidney Disease

FOR the purpose of altering the composition of the membership of the State Commission on Kidney Disease; authorizing the Commission to designate certain necessary staff for certain purposes; authorizing the Commission to appoint an executive director; providing that the executive director shall have duties as specified by the Commission and shall serve at the pleasure of the Commission; authorizing the Commission to collect certain fees; authorizing the Commission to certify a dialysis or transplant center that meets certain standards; and generally relating to the State Commission on Kidney Disease.
