

(5) WAS SELF-EMPLOYED (INCLUDING EMPLOYMENT AS A FARMER, A RANCHER, OR A FISHERMAN) BUT IS UNEMPLOYED AS A RESULT OF GENERAL ECONOMIC CONDITIONS IN THE COMMUNITY IN WHICH THE INDIVIDUAL RESIDES OR BECAUSE OF NATURAL DISASTERS; OR.

(6) IS A DISPLACED HOMEMAKER.

(c) ["Economically disadvantaged"] "LOW-INCOME individual" means an individual who:

(1) receives, or is a member of a family which receives, cash welfare payments under a federal, State, or local [welfare] INCOME-BASED PUBLIC ASSISTANCE program;

(2) [has] RECEIVED AN INCOME, or is a member of a family [which has,] THAT received a total family income for the 6-month period prior to application for the program involved (exclusive of unemployment compensation, child support payments, [and welfare] payments DESCRIBED IN PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION, AND OLD AGE AND SURVIVORS INSURANCE BENEFITS RECEIVED UNDER SECTION 202 OF THE SOCIAL SECURITY ACT (42 U.S.C. 402)) [which] THAT, in relation to family size, [was not in excess of] DOES NOT EXCEED the higher of:

(I) the poverty level [determined in accordance with criteria established by the United States Office of Management and Budget, or] FOR AN EQUIVALENT PERIOD; OR

(II) 70 percent of the lower living standard income level FOR AN EQUIVALENT PERIOD;

(3) [is receiving] IS A MEMBER OF A HOUSEHOLD THAT RECEIVES FOOD STAMPS OR HAS BEEN DETERMINED WITHIN THE 6-MONTH PERIOD PRIOR TO APPLICATION FOR THE PROGRAM INVOLVED TO BE ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE food stamps pursuant to the Food Stamp Act of 1977 (7 U.S.C. 2011 ET SEQ.);

(4) is a foster child on behalf of whom State or local government payments are made; [or]

(5) in cases permitted by regulations [of] PROMULGATED BY the Secretary, is an [adult handicapped] individual WITH A DISABILITY whose own income meets the requirements of A PROGRAM DESCRIBED IN paragraph (1) or (2) of this subsection, but who is a member of a family whose income does not meet such requirements; OR.

(6) QUALIFIES AS A HOMELESS INDIVIDUAL, AS DEFINED IN SUBSECTIONS (A) AND (C) OF § 103 OF THE STEWART B. MCKINNEY HOMELESS ASSISTANCE ACT (42 U.S.C. 11302).

(d) "Federal Act" means the federal [Job Training Partnership] WORKFORCE INVESTMENT Act.

(e) "Governor's plan" means the [Governor's coordination and special services plan] STATE PLAN as provided in [§ 121] § 112 of the federal Act.
