

as having barriers to employment, including, but not limited to, displaced homemakers, school dropouts, teenage parents, [handicapped] INDIVIDUALS WITH DISABILITIES, older workers, [and veterans] VETERANS, AND OTHER PARTICIPANTS AS DEFINED BY THE FEDERAL ACT.

(c) The County Commissioners of Carroll County may appropriate funds necessary to enter into contracts with private or public enterprises for the training or retraining of workers of those enterprises.

(a) The [State council] GOVERNOR'S WORKFORCE INVESTMENT BOARD is established and shall have the membership as provided in [ § 702] § 111 of the federal Act.

(b) The [State council] GOVERNOR'S WORKFORCE INVESTMENT BOARD may not have more than 40 members appointed by the Governor for staggered terms set by the Governor by executive order.

(c) The [State council] GOVERNOR'S WORKFORCE INVESTMENT BOARD shall be funded [as provided in § 703] CONSISTENT WITH §§ 111 AND 128 of the federal Act and shall have personnel and appropriations as are provided in the State budget.

(d) The [State council] GOVERNOR'S WORKFORCE INVESTMENT BOARD shall perform the duties [of a single State human resource investment council as provided in Article VII of the federal Act with respect to:

(1) the programs described in:

(i) the federal Act;

(ii) the Carl D. Perkins Vocational and Applied Technology Education Act;

(iii) the National and Community Service Act of 1990;

(iv) the Adult Education Act;

(v) the Wagner-Peyser Act; and

(vi) Part F of Title IV of the Social Security Act;

(2) the employment program established under § 6(d)(4) of the Food Stamp Act of 1977; and

(3) each human resource program designated by the Governor by executive order] AND FUNCTIONS IDENTIFIED IN § 111 OF THE FEDERAL ACT AND OTHER FUNCTIONS DESIGNATED BY THE GOVERNOR AS NECESSARY TO IMPROVE THE QUALITY OF THE STATE'S WORKFORCE.

(e) The [State council] GOVERNOR'S WORKFORCE INVESTMENT BOARD may adopt any rule or regulations necessary to carry out its powers and duties.
