CHAPTER 317

(House Bill 1270)

AN ACT concerning

State Acupuncture Board - Auricular Detoxification

FOR the purpose of allowing an individual who is certain individuals who are licensed or certified to practice a certain health occupation occupations in the State to provide auricular detoxification under certain supervision by an acupuncturist licensed by the State Acupuncture Board; providing for the qualifications and training of the individual; exempting the individual from obtaining a license to practice acupuncture in the State; providing for the settings where an individual may provide auricular detoxification; authorizing the State Acupuncture Board to adopt certain regulations; providing for certain disciplinary procedures; defining certain terms; requiring the State Acupuncture Board to prepare a certain evaluation and submit a certain report on or before a certain date; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating to acupuncture.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Health Occupations

1A-101.

- (a) In this title the following words have the meanings indicated.
- (b) "Acupuncture" means a form of health care, based on a theory of energetic physiology, that describes the interrelationship of the body organs or functions with an associated point or combination of points.
- (c) "AURICULAR DETOXIFICATION" MEANS AN ACUPUNCTURE TECHNIQUE INVOLVING THE NEEDLING OF THE EXTERNAL AURICLE OF THE HUMAN EAR FOR THE PURPOSE OF ASSISTING IN THE REMOVAL OF TOXIC OR A PERSON WHO IS UNDERGOING DETOXIFICATION TO REMOVE ADDICTIVE SUBSTANCES FROM THE BODY AND RESTORING HEALTH.
