

(ii) has been given the authority by the insurer to resolve all issues involved in the proceeding; OR

(6) THE INDIVIDUAL IS REPRESENTING A UNIT OF STATE GOVERNMENT, AT THE DIRECTION OF THE UNIT OF STATE GOVERNMENT.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2001.

CHAPTER 323
(House Bill 1347)

AN ACT concerning

Worcester County - Board of Education - Election of Members

FOR the purpose of providing that members to the Worcester County Board of Education shall be elected; establishing a procedure for the election of members to the Worcester County Board of Education; providing for the termination of the incumbent appointed members holding office on a certain date under certain circumstances; establishing a certain term of office for elected members; providing for the removal of members under certain circumstances; providing for certain student nonvoting members; providing a procedure for filling a vacancy on the County Board; providing for the election of the president and vice president of the County Board; providing for the compensation of the members of the County Board; requiring the County Board to meet at certain intervals; altering the number of members on the County Board, subject to a certain contingency; providing for the construction of this Act; making certain portions of this Act subject to certain contingencies; and generally relating to the election of members to the Worcester County Board of Education.
