

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Education

3-105.

(e) The Worcester County Board consists of seven [members and includes the five members serving on July 1, 1974 and the two additional members appointed on July 1, 1974. One of the additional members serves for a term of 4 years and the other for a term of 5 years and, at the expiration of these terms, they or their successors serve for a term of 5 years each] VOTING MEMBERS AND ONE NONVOTING STUDENT MEMBER FROM EACH PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL IN THE COUNTY.

(a) In the following counties, the members of the county board shall be elected:

- (1) Allegany;
- (2) Calvert;
- (3) Carroll;
- (4) Charles;
- (5) Frederick;
- (6) Garrett;
- (7) Howard;
- (8) Kent;
- (9) Prince George's;
- (10) Montgomery;
- (11) St. Mary's;
- (12) Somerset; [and]
- (13) Washington; AND
- (14) WORCESTER.

SUBTITLE 14. WORCESTER COUNTY.

3-1401.

(A) THE WORCESTER COUNTY BOARD CONSISTS OF SEVEN VOTING MEMBERS AND ONE NONVOTING STUDENT MEMBER FROM EACH PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL IN THE COUNTY.

(B) (1) THE SEVEN VOTING MEMBERS OF THE WORCESTER COUNTY BOARD SHALL BE ELECTED AT A GENERAL ELECTION.
