(e) The Worcester County Board consists of seven [members and includes the five members serving on July 1, 1974 and the two additional members appointed on July 1, 1974. One of the additional members serves for a term of 4 years and the other for a term of 5 years and, at the expiration of these terms, they or their successors serve for a term of 5 years each] VOTING MEMBERS AND ONE NONVOTING STUDENT MEMBER FROM EACH PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL IN THE COUNTY.

## SUBTITLE 14. WORCESTER COUNTY.

3-1401.

- (A) THE WORCESTER COUNTY BOARD CONSISTS OF SEVEN VOTING MEMBERS AND ONE NONVOTING STUDENT MEMBER FROM EACH PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL IN THE COUNTY.
- (B) (1) THE SEVEN VOTING MEMBERS OF THE WORCESTER COUNTY BOARD SHALL BE ELECTED AT A GENERAL ELECTION.
