- (B) EXCEPT FOR THOSE ACTIONS AUTHORIZED BY SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, ALL ACTIONS OF THE COUNTY BOARD SHALL BE TAKEN AT A PUBLIC MEETING AND A RECORD OF THE MEETING AND ALL ACTIONS SHALL BE MADE PUBLIC.
- (C) THE COUNTY BOARD MAY TAKE ACTIONS IN EXECUTIVE SESSION IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 10–508 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.

(e) The Worcester County Board consists of [seven members and includes the five members serving on July 1, 1974 and the two additional members appointed on July 1, 1974. One of the additional members serves for a term of 4 years and the other for a term of 5 years and, at the expiration of these terms, they or their successors serve for a term of 5 years each] FIVE VOTING MEMBERS AND ONE NONVOTING STUDENT MEMBER FROM EACH PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL IN THE COUNTY.
