(A) THE COUNTY BOARD SHALL MEET AT LEAST ONCE EACH MONTH.

(B) EXCEPT FOR THOSE ACTIONS AUTHORIZED BY SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, ALL ACTIONS OF THE COUNTY BOARD SHALL BE TAKEN AT A PUBLIC MEETING AND A RECORD OF THE MEETING AND ALL ACTIONS SHALL BE MADE PUBLIC.

(C) THE COUNTY BOARD MAY TAKE ACTIONS IN EXECUTIVE SESSION IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 10-508 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

### Article - Education

3-105.

(e) The Worcester County Board consists of [seven members and includes the five members serving on July 1, 1974 and the two additional members appointed on July 1, 1974. One of the additional members serves for a term of 4 years and the other for a term of 5 years and, at the expiration of these terms, they or their successors serve for a term of 5 years each] FIVE VOTING MEMBERS AND ONE NONVOTING STUDENT MEMBER FROM EACH PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL IN THE COUNTY.
