

(b) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, on receipt of the settlement proceeds the University shall deposit the settlement proceeds directly into the endowment.

(c) The University System of Maryland shall maintain, manage, invest, and expend the settlement proceeds and any investment earnings from the settlement proceeds exclusively for the benefit of Frostburg State University.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted.

CHAPTER 331

(House Bill 1409)

AN ACT concerning

University of Maryland Police Force

FOR the purpose of authorizing the use of a campus security force or building guards in addition to a campus police force at a constituent institution of the University of Maryland; and generally relating to the University of Maryland Police Force.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article - Education

Section 13-601

Annotated Code of Maryland

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Education

13-601.

(a) There is a University of Maryland Police Force.

(b) (1) A University of Maryland police officer is and has all the powers of a peace and police officer in this State.

(2) However, a University of Maryland police officer may exercise these powers only on property that is owned, leased, operated by, or under the control of the University of Maryland. The police officer may not exercise these powers on any other property unless:
