- (ii) [At least 1 individual, in addition to the driver, be in attendance on the ambulance during each transport who] PROVIDE:
- 1. [Is] AT LEAST ONE INDIVIDUAL, IN ADDITION TO THE DRIVER, IN ATTENDANCE DURING TREATMENT OR TRANSPORT WHO IS certified or licensed [by the State as an emergency medical technician] under § 13–516 of this subtitle FOR THE APPROPRIATE LEVEL FOR THE CARE TO BE RENDERED; or
- 2. [Has successfully completed a course of training determined by the Institute to be substantially equivalent to the training necessary for certification or licensure as an emergency medical technician] PERSONNEL EQUIVALENT OR SUPERIOR TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF ITEM 1 OF THIS SUBPARAGRAPH AS DEMONSTRATED TO THE INSTITUTE INCLUDING:
  - A. LICENSED PHYSICIANS;
  - B. LICENSED NURSES; OR
  - C. LICENSED RESPIRATORY THERAPISTS; and
- (iii) **[**Each**] HAVE EACH** ambulance **[**operated by the ambulance service be**] WHICH THE COMMERCIAL EMERCENCY MEDICAL SERVICE OPERATES** inspected:
- 1. [Once] FOR AN AMBULANCE INTENDED FOR USE ON A ROADWAY, ONCE every 12 months by an inspection station licensed under § 23-103 of the Transportation Article and be issued an inspection certificate by the inspection station; or
- 2. [In accordance with the] FOR ANY OTHER TYPE OF AMBULANCE, UNDER ANY ALL APPLICABLE STATE AND FEDERAL INSPECTION requirements for the [operation of an ambulance owned, operated, or under the jurisdiction of a unit of State government, a political subdivision of the State, or a volunteer fire company or volunteer rescue squad in the jurisdiction where the ambulance service is located] TYPE OF AMBULANCE.
- **f**(d)**f**(E) To qualify for **f**an ambulance**f** A COMMERCIAL EMERCENCY MEDICAL service license, an applicant shall:
- (1) Pay [to] the Institute an application fee established [in accordance with] UNDER this section;
- (2) Maintain commercial general liability insurance [that provides] for at least \$1 million in coverage in [the form of] an insurance policy issued by an insurer acceptable to the Maryland Insurance Commissioner to write such policies in the State;
- (3) Provide [to] the Institute a certificate of insurance that at a minimum:
- (i) Indicates that the insurance required under this subsection is in effect [at the time] WHEN the application is submitted; and
