

(h) The grant of a certificate by the Commission to [an electric company] ANY PERSON under subsection (e) of this section constitutes:

(1) authority for the [company] PERSON to dredge and construct bulkheads in the waters or private wetlands of the State and to appropriate or use the waters; and

(2) registration AND A PERMIT TO CONSTRUCT ~~for~~ [the construction of] ~~any facility necessary to control emissions into the air resulting from the operation of the generating station,~~ as required under Title 2, Subtitle 4 of the Environment Article.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect ~~October~~ July 1, 2001.

CHAPTER 348

(Senate Bill 51)

AN ACT concerning

Vehicle Laws - Trucks, Truck Tractors, and Buses - Identification

FOR the purpose of requiring that a certain identification number be displayed on trucks, truck tractors, and buses in a certain manner; repealing certain identifying information requirements; repealing certain exemptions from the identification number requirement; exempting certain vehicles owned and operated by the State or certain political subdivisions from certain identification number requirements; altering the time period during which an exemption from certain identification number requirements applies; providing for a delayed effective date; and generally relating to the identification of trucks, truck tractors, and buses.
