CHAPTER 350

(Senate Bill 59)

AN ACT concerning

Vehicle Laws - Driver Education

FOR the purpose requiring that driving instructors complete a certain program before being licensed and employed by a drivers' school; providing clarifying that an individual who holds a learner's instructional permit may not take a certain examination for a provisional license sooner than a certain time period, until completing a certain drivers' education program, and until submitting a certain required skills log; requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration to adopt and enforce certain regulations in consultation with the State Department of Education; modifying certain definitions; and generally relating to drivers' education and the drivers' education program.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Transportation

15 - 701.

- (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.
- (b) (1) "Drivers' school" means, except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, any person in the business of giving instruction in the driving of motor vehicles.
 - (2) "Drivers' school" does not include:
- (i) Any public school or other noncollegiate educational institution [approved by the State Board of Education] GIVING INSTRUCTION IN THE DRIVING OF MOTOR VEHICLES DURING ITS NORMAL SCHOOL HOURS AND NOT CHARGING A FEE FOR THIS INSTRUCTION; or
