SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 1 of this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three—fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and Section 1 of this Act shall take effect from the date it is enacted. It shall remain effective until the taking effect of Section 2 of this Act takes effect, Section 1 of this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

SECTION-4: AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, subject to the provisions of Section 3 of this Act, this Act shall take effect October 1, 2001.

<u>SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 2 of this Act shall take effect October 1, 2001.</u>

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all of the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and except as provided in Section 3 of this Act, shall take effect from the date it is enacted. Section 1 of this Act shall remain effective until the taking effect of Section 2 of this Act. On the taking effect of Section 2 of this Act, Section 1 of this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

CHAPTER 357

(Senate Bill 140)

AN ACT concerning

Creation of a State Debt - Baltimore County - The Community Learning Center

FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$400,000 \$200,000 \$250,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Directors of the Islamic Society of Baltimore, Inc. for certain development or improvement purposes; prohibiting the use of the proceeds of the sale of the bonds and the matching fund for religious purposes; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject to a requirement that the grantee provide and expend a matching fund; and providing generally for the issuance and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That:

(1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Baltimore County – The Community Learning Center Loan of 2001 in the total principal amount equal to the lesser of (i) \$400,000 \$200,000 \$250,000 or (ii) the amount of the
