8-703.

- (a) (1) Unless authorized to practice registered nursing under this title, a person may not represent to the public by title, by description of services, methods, or procedures, or otherwise, that the person is authorized to practice registered nursing in this State.
- (2) Unless authorized to practice licensed practical nursing under this title, a person may not represent to the public by title, by description of services, methods, or procedures, or otherwise, that the person is authorized to practice licensed practical nursing in this State.
- (3) UNLESS AUTHORIZED TO PROVIDE PATIENT CARE AS A CERTIFIED NURSING ASSISTANT OR MEDICATION ASSISTANT UNDER THIS TITLE, A PERSON MAY NOT REPRESENT TO THE PUBLIC BY TITLE, BY DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES, METHODS, OR PROCEDURES, OR OTHERWISE, THAT THE PERSON IS AUTHORIZED TO PROVIDE CARE AS A CERTIFIED NURSING ASSISTANT OR MEDICATION ASSISTANT IN THIS STATE.
- (4) UNLESS AUTHORIZED TO PROVIDE PATIENT CARE IN A SPECIFIC CATEGORY OF CERTIFIED NURSING ASSISTANT, A PERSON MAY NOT REPRESENT TO THE PUBLIC BY TITLE, BY DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES, METHODS, OR PROCEDURES, OR OTHERWISE, THAT THE PERSON IS AUTHORIZED TO PROVIDE CARE AS A CERTIFIED NURSING ASSISTANT IN A SPECIFIC CATEGORY IN THIS STATE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That on or before January 31, 2002, the Board of Nursing shall adopt regulations to implement this Act.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That on or before October 1, 2001, the Board of Nursing shall report to the Nursing Home Quality Oversight Committee and to the General Assembly House Environmental Matters Committee and the Senate Economic and Environmental Affairs Committee, in accordance with § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, on the implementation of this Act.

SECTION 3. 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2001.
