the value of a motor home or travel trailer traded in as part of the consideration for the sale of the motor home or travel trailer by a licensed dealer certain licensed dealers; authorizing the Department of Business and Economic Development to develop and implement, in cooperation with certain entities, a marketing and tourism plan to promote the use of motor homes and travel trailers in the State; providing that a certain exemption from the motor vehicle titling tax does not apply until certain bonds are no longer outstanding and unpaid; prohibiting the Motor Vehicle Administration from collecting the motor vehicle titling providing that the definitions modified by this Act do not apply to the calculation of the vehicle excise tax imposed on a motor home or a travel trailer until certain bonds are no longer outstanding and unpaid; requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration to collect a reduced motor vehicle excise tax on certain vehicles in certain fiscal years; providing for the application of this Act; providing for the termination of certain provisions of this Act; and generally relating to motor homes and travel trailers.

"Motor home" means a motor vehicle that is designed and constructed primarily to provide living quarters for recreational, camping, or travel use.

- (a) "Travel trailer" means a vehicle that:
 - (1) Is mounted on wheels:
- (2) Is of such a size and weight as not to require any special highway movement permit when towed by a motor vehicle;
- (3) Is designed and constructed primarily to provide temporary living quarters for recreational, camping, or travel use; and
 - (4) Is no longer than 40 feet.
