SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 89 - Miscellaneous Business, Work, and Safety Provisions 49B.

- (a) An elevator, dumbwaiter, escalator or moving walk may not be operated in any building, structure, or place of employment in the State unless a certificate of registration and inspection for the operation thereof is issued by the Commissioner of Labor and Industry, and unless the certificate remains in effect and is kept posted conspicuously in or on the elevator, dumbwaiter, escalator or moving walk.
