- (B) "DIRECTOR" MEANS THE DIRECTOR OF THE HEARING AID LOAN BANK PROGRAM.
  - (C) "ELIGIBLE CHILD" MEANS A CHILD WHO:
    - (1) IS A RESIDENT OF THE STATE;

- (D) "LICENSED AUDIOLOGIST" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS LICENSED TO PRACTICE AUDIOLOGY UNDER TITLE 2 OF THE HEALTH OCCUPATIONS ARTICLE.
  - (E) "LOAN BANK" MEANS THE HEARING AID LOAN BANK.
- (F) "PROGRAM" MEANS THE HEARING AID LOAN BANK PROGRAM. 8–502.
  - (A) THERE IS A HEARING AID LOAN BANK PROGRAM IN THE DEPARTMENT.
- (B) THE PROGRAM IS ESTABLISHED FOR THE PURPOSE OF LENDING HEARING AIDS ON A TEMPORARY BASIS TO A PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN OF AN ELIGIBLE CHILD TO ENSURE THAT CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF 4  $\underline{3}$  YEARS WILL HAVE MAXIMUM AUDITORY INPUT DURING THE CRITICAL PERIOD OF LANGUAGE LEARNING.
