- (A) THE CONTRACT BETWEEN THE PROGRAM PARTICIPANT AND THE SERVICE PROVIDER SHALL PROVIDE THAT MONEY MAY BE WITHDRAWN BY A PROGRAM PARTICIPANT FROM AN INDIVIDUAL DEVELOPMENT ACCOUNT OTHER THAN FOR QUALIFIED PURPOSES ONLY FOR EMERGENCIES:
 - (1) AS DETERMINED BY THE DEPARTMENT; AND
 - (2) IF REPLACED WITHIN 6 12 MONTHS.
