CHAPTER 378

(Senate Bill 361)

AN ACT concerning

Creation of a State Debt - Maryland 4-H Facilities

FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt ~~in the amount of \$820,000~~ ~~\$250,000~~ *not to exceed \$200,000*, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Directors of the Maryland 4-H Foundation, Inc. for certain development or improvement purposes; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject to a requirement that the grantee provide and expend a matching fund; and providing generally for the issuance and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That:

(1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Maryland
