SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Insurance

19-513.

(e) Benefits payable under the coverages described in §§ 19-505 and 19-509 of this subtitle shall be reduced to the extent ~~[that]~~ **THAT**.

~~(1) the recipient has recovered benefits under the workers' compensation laws of a state or the federal government FOR WHICH THE PROVIDER OF THE WORKERS' COMPENSATION BENEFITS HAS NOT BEEN REIMBURSED; AND~~

~~(2) A BENEFITS PROVIDER, EMPLOYER, OR INSURER HAS FAILED TO RECOVER REIMBURSEMENT EQUAL TO THE BENEFITS PROVIDED TO THE RECIPIENT UNDER THE WORKERS' COMPENSATION LAWS OF A STATE OR THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT.~~

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2001.

CHAPTER 393

(Senate Bill 533)

AN ACT concerning

Law Enforcement Officers' Pension System - Membership - Martin State Airport Firefighters
