CHAPTER 409

(Senate Bill 618)

AN ACT concerning

Higher Education - Nursing Scholarships - Awards

FOR the purpose of increasing the maximum annual award and the maximum total award for a nursing scholarship under the program of Economic Development Student Assistance Grants; increasing the maximum annual award and the maximum total award for an additional grant that may be awarded to nursing scholarship recipients under the program; increasing the maximum award of a nursing scholarship for certain nursing students; and generally relating to nursing scholarships under the program of Economic Development Student Assistance Grants.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Education

18-706.

(a) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated.

(1) "Eligible organization" means an institution, including a licensed hospital, nursing home, adult day care center, public health agency, home health agency, or other organization authorized by the Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene.

(2) "Eligible institution" means an institution of postsecondary education:

(i) Approved to operate by the Maryland Higher Education Commission; and
