8-109. RULES OF PROCEDURE.

TITLE 9. EXTRADITION.

9-101. DEFINITIONS.

(A) IN GENERAL.

IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

(B) EXECUTIVE AUTHORITY.

IN THIS TITLE, "EXECUTIVE AUTHORITY" INCLUDES THE GOVERNOR AND ANY PERSON PERFORMING THE FUNCTIONS OF GOVERNOR IN A STATE OTHER THAN THIS STATE.

(C) STATE.

(1) "STATE" MEANS A STATE OTHER THAN THIS STATE.

(2) "STATE" INCLUDES ANY OTHER STATE OR TERRITORY OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA.
