

3. "CONTROLLED DANGEROUS SUBSTANCE ANALOGUE"  
DOES NOT INCLUDE:

- (I) A CONTROLLED DANGEROUS SUBSTANCE;
- (II) A SUBSTANCE FOR WHICH THERE IS AN APPROVED NEW  
DRUG APPLICATION; OR
- (III) A SUBSTANCE EXEMPTED FOR INVESTIGATIONAL USE  
UNDER SECTION 506 OF THE FEDERAL FOOD, DRUG, AND COSMETIC ACT.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
October 1, 2001.

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## CHAPTER 442

### (House Bill 46)

AN ACT concerning

#### **Honorable Louis L. Goldstein Volunteer Police, Fire, Rescue, and Emergency Medical Services Personnel Subtraction Modification Program**

qualifying volunteer police, fire, rescue, and emergency medical services  
personnel after the Honorable Louis L. Goldstein.

BY adding to

Article - Tax - General

Section 10-213

Annotated Code of Maryland

(1997 Replacement Volume and 2000 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

#### **Article - Tax - General**

10-213.

THE SUBTRACTION MODIFICATIONS FOR VOLUNTEER POLICE, FIRE, RESCUE,  
AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES PERSONNEL UNDER § 10-208(I-1) AND (L) OF  
THIS SUBTITLE SHALL BE KNOWN AS THE HONORABLE LOUIS L. GOLDSTEIN  
VOLUNTEER POLICE, FIRE, RESCUE, AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES  
PERSONNEL SUBTRACTION MODIFICATION PROGRAM.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
October 1, 2001.
