

COMPANY INSURES IN THE STATE AND TRACK THE DATES THEIR CERTIFICATE INSPECTIONS ARE DUE TO ENSURE THAT THE CERTIFICATE INSPECTIONS ARE DUE AND COMPLETED AS REQUIRED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE;

~~(II) SUBMIT A COPY OF THE DATABASE TO THE CHIEF BOILER INSPECTOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF DEVELOPING THE DATABASE; AND~~

~~(III) WITHIN 60 DAYS OF AN INSURANCE POLICY BEING WRITTEN, CANCELED, NOT RENEWED, OR SUSPENDED, SUBMIT AN UPDATED DATABASE TO THE CHIEF BOILER INSPECTOR THAT REFLECTS THE CHANGE; AND~~

(4) ~~(H)~~ DEVELOP ~~AND~~, MAINTAIN, AND MAKE AVAILABLE TO THE COMMISSIONER A QUALITY ASSURANCE PROGRAM IN ACCORDANCE WITH REGULATIONS ADOPTED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE ;

~~(II) SUBMIT A COPY OF THE QUALITY ASSURANCE PROGRAM TO THE CHIEF BOILER INSPECTOR, WHICH SHALL BE DEEMED CONFIDENTIAL; AND~~

~~(III) IF THE QUALITY ASSURANCE PROGRAM IS MODIFIED, SUBMIT AN UPDATED COPY OF THE QUALITY ASSURANCE PROGRAM TO THE CHIEF BOILER INSPECTOR WITHIN 60 DAYS OF THE CHANGES BEING MADE.~~

(B) IF MORE THAN ONE INSURANCE COMPANY PROVIDES INSURANCE FOR A BOILER OR PRESSURE VESSEL OR IF AN OWNER-USER EMPLOYS AN INDIVIDUAL WITH A SPECIAL INSPECTOR COMMISSION, THE INSURANCE COMPANIES OR OWNER-USER:

(1) MAY AGREE TO COORDINATE INSPECTIONS TO ENSURE THAT THE BOILER OR PRESSURE VESSEL IS INSPECTED; AND

(2) SHALL ~~DOCUMENT ANY AGREEMENT TO~~ ENSURE THAT RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE INSPECTION IS CLEARLY DEFINED.

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A PERSON THAT REPAIRS OR ALTERS A BOILER OR PRESSURE VESSEL SHALL:

(1) PROVIDE NOTICE TO, AND RECEIVE APPROVAL FROM, THE CHIEF BOILER INSPECTOR, A DEPUTY BOILER INSPECTOR, OR A SPECIAL INSPECTOR PRIOR TO COMMENCING A REPAIR OR ALTERATION THAT:

(I) AFFECTS THE WORKING PRESSURE OR SAFETY OF A BOILER OR PRESSURE VESSEL; OR

(II) INVOLVES FUSION WELDING;

(2) REPAIR THE BOILER OR PRESSURE VESSEL IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE COMMISSIONER; AND

(3) PROVIDE REPORTS, AS REQUIRED BY REGULATIONS ADOPTED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE, TO THE CHIEF BOILER INSPECTOR AND THE OWNER OF THE BOILER OR PRESSURE VESSEL.
