SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 41 – Governor – Executive and Administrative Departments

20-103.

(a) (1) The Board of Directors shall appoint an Executive Director who shall serve at the pleasure of the Board.

(2) The salary of the Executive Director shall be determined by the Board.

(b) (1) The Executive Director shall be the chief administrative officer for the Corporation and as such shall direct and supervise the administrative affairs and technical activities of the Corporation in accordance with policies and procedures established by the Board of Directors.

(2) The Executive Director or the Executive Director's designee shall:

(i) Attend all meetings of the Board of Directors, act as Secretary to the Board, and keep minutes of all its proceedings;

(ii) Approve all accounts for salaries, per diem payments, and allowable expenses of the Corporation or of any of its employees or consultants, and any expenses incidental to the operation of the Corporation; and

(iii) Perform any other duties as directed by the Board of Directors in carrying out the purposes of this subtitle.

(c) The Board of Directors shall appoint any additional professional and clerical staff necessary to carry out the purposes of this subtitle AND SHALL ESTABLISH COMPENSATION, HOLIDAYS, AND LEAVE FOR THE STAFF. The officers or
