CHAPTER 449

(House Bill 192)

AN ACT concerning

Crimes - Drugs - 3, 4-Methylenedioxymethamphetamine (MDMA) - Penalties

FOR the purpose of establishing that a person who manufactures, distributes, dispenses, or possesses a certain controlled dangerous substance in a certain quantity is subject to certain additional penalties for certain controlled dangerous substances violations; ~~adding a certain controlled dangerous substance in a certain quantity to the list of drugs and their quantities that are actionable under certain drug kingpin laws;~~ and generally relating to penalties for controlled dangerous substances violations.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments

286.

(a) Except as authorized by this subheading, it is unlawful for any person:

(1) To manufacture, distribute, or dispense, or to possess a controlled dangerous substance in sufficient quantity to reasonably indicate under all circumstances an intent to manufacture, distribute, or dispense, a controlled dangerous substance;

(2) To create, distribute, or possess with intent to distribute, a counterfeit controlled dangerous substance;
