

CHAPTER 453**(House Bill 215)**

AN ACT concerning

Election Code – Compensation of Election Judges – Harford County

FOR the purpose of providing for the salary of the election judges in Harford County; providing that this Act does not apply to the salary or compensation of the incumbent election judges in Harford County; and generally relating to the salary of the election judges in Harford County.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 33 – Election Code

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 33 – Election Code

10-205.

(a) A local board may fix the compensation of election judges within the limits authorized for this purpose by the county's governing body.

(b) (1) In Allegany County, the compensation for each day actually served may not be less than:

- (i) \$100 per day for each chief election judge; and
- (ii) \$80 per day for every other election judge.

(2) In Baltimore City, the compensation for each election day actually served shall be:

- (i) \$150 per day for each chief election judge; and
- (ii) \$125 per day for every other election judge.

(3) In Baltimore County, the compensation for each election day actually served shall be:

- (i) \$160 per day for each chief election judge; and
- (ii) \$125 per day for every other election judge.

(4) In Calvert County, the compensation for each election day actually served shall be:

- (i) \$125 per day for each chief election judge; and
