

2. DURING A DOUBLEHEADER GAME, AFTER THE BEGINNING OF THE SIXTH INNING OF THE SECOND GAME.

(c) A licensee may not:

(1) Allow alcoholic beverages or light wine to be consumed on his premises after 2:15 a.m. or before 8:00 a.m. the same morning; or

(2) Allow alcoholic beverages glasses, bottles, or containers to remain on tables or serving counters after 2:30 a.m.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2001.

AN ACT concerning

Harford County – Alcoholic Beverages – Caterers

FOR the purpose of authorizing persons ~~who~~ that are licensed as caterers in Harford County to provide food and keep and sell at retail alcoholic beverages for ~~their own events on their own premises~~ consumption only on the premises of the caterer at a self-sponsored event held once during a calendar year on a day selected by the caterer; ~~altering a certain definition~~; and generally relating to licensed caterers in Harford County.
