- [(s)] (U) "Permit" means a permit issued by the Secretary under this subtitle that authorizes the holder of the permit to do any act that is within the scope of the permit.
 - [(t)] (V) "Raw milk" means unpasteurized milk.
- [(u)](W) "Receiving station" means any place where, for delivery to a milk plant, raw milk is collected, cooled, and stored.
- [(v)](X) "Transfer station" means a place where milk is transferred directly from a milk tank truck to another milk tank truck for delivery to a milk plant.
- (a) Except as otherwise provided in this section, a person shall obtain a permit with a Grade A or a manufactured grade classification from the Secretary before that person may:
 - (1) Bring, send, or receive a milk product into this State for sale;
 - (2) Offer a milk product for sale;
 - (3) Give a milk product away; [or]
 - (4) Store a milk product; OR
 - (5) TRANSPORT A MILK PRODUCT.
 - (b) A permit is required to:
 - (1) Be a bobtailer;
 - (2) BE A BULK MILK HAULER/SAMPLER;
 - [(2)](3) Be a certified industry dairy farm inspector;
 - [(3)](4) Be a milk processor;
 - [(4)](5) Be a milk producer;
 - [(5) Be a milk hauler;]
 - (6) Operate a distribution station;
 - (7) OPERATE A MILK TRANSPORTATION COMPANY;
 - [(7)] (8) Operate a receiving station; or
 - [(8)] (9) Operate a transfer station.
 - (c) A permit is not required for:
- (1) A milk producer who is outside the departmental inspection area if the raw milk from that milk producer is processed by a milk processor who holds a permit issued under this subtitle;
