the amount of the matching fund to the State Treasurer, and the proceeds of the loan equal to the amount of the matching fund shall be expended for the purposes provided in this Act. Any amount of the loan in excess of the amount of the matching fund certified by the Board of Public Works shall be canceled and be of no further effect.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2001.

## **CHAPTER 483**

(House Bill 504)

## Criminal Injuries Compensation - Claimants and Awards

FOR the purpose of expanding the definition of crime to include certain motor vehicle crimes for purposes of determining eligibility for criminal injuries compensation; allowing eertain family members parents, children, or spouses who reside with certain persons to be eligible for certain criminal injuries compensation awards; altering the circumstances under which the Criminal Injuries Compensation Board may make an award for a crime or delinquent act resulting in certain psychological injury; eliminating certain financial hardship requirements relating to criminal injury compensation, allowing the Board to make an award for repairing, replacing, or cleaning property under certain circumstances; establishing a certain monetary limit on the award the Board is allowed to make for repairing, replacing, or cleaning property; allowing the Board to make an award for certain disability or dependency claims; establishing certain limits for certain counseling for certain family members parents, children, or spouses of certain persons; and generally relating to criminal injuries compensation.
