

**CHAPTER 488****(House Bill 607)**

AN ACT concerning

**Harford County - Alcoholic Beverages - Class BDR (Deluxe Restaurant)  
Licenses**

FOR the purpose of creating in Harford County a special 7-day Class B (on-sale) license known as the Class BDR (deluxe restaurant) beer, wine and liquor license; restricting the issuance of ~~a certain~~ a certain Class BDR ~~license~~ licenses for restaurants that are located in a certain area of Harford County and that meet certain requirements; setting a certain annual license fee; requiring the Liquor Control Board to adopt certain regulations; exempting from certain stock ownership requirements certain applicants for Class BDR licenses; authorizing the Liquor Control Board to issue not more than ~~four~~ a certain number of licenses of a certain class to an individual for the use of a sole proprietorship, partnership, corporation, unincorporated association, or limited liability company; defining certain terms; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages licenses in Harford County.
