

(D) REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES.

A MEMBER OF THE ADVISORY BOARD:

(1) SHALL SERVE WITHOUT COMPENSATION; BUT

(2) IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS, AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.

(E) STAFF.

SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE HEAD OF THE APPROPRIATE UNIT, THE ADVISORY BOARD MAY USE THE STAFF AND FACILITIES OF THE DEPARTMENT, THE ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE OF THE COURTS, AND THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF CRIME CONTROL AND PREVENTION IN THE PERFORMANCE OF ITS FUNCTIONS.

REVISOR'S NOTE: Subsections (a), (b), (d), and (e) of this section are new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 27, § 744(d), (e), the sixth sentence of (a) and the second and third sentences of (b).

Subsection (c) of this section is new language added for clarity.

In subsections (a) and (b)(1) of this section, the references to members "of the Advisory Board" are added for clarity.

In subsection (a) of this section, the reference to a majority of the members "then serving" on the Advisory Board is added for clarity.

In subsection (a) of this section, the former reference to "their designees" is deleted to avoid ambiguity as to what constitutes a "majority".

Also in subsection (a) of this section, the former phrase "for the transaction of business" is deleted in light of the word "quorum".

In subsection (b)(2) of this section, the introductory phrase, "[f]rom the persons the Secretary recommends to the Governor to serve on the Advisory Board", is added for clarity.

In subsection (e) of this section, the reference to the "appropriate unit" is substituted for the former reference to the "respective department or agency" to conform to the terminology used throughout this article. See General Revisor's Note to article.

The Criminal Procedure Article Review Committee notes, for consideration by the General Assembly, that in subsection (b)(1) of this section, the meaning of the requirement that the Executive Director of the Governor's Office of Crime Control and Prevention, the Attorney General, and two members of the Advisory Board serve on the Advisory Board as "ex officio members" is unclear. The term is not used in § 10-208(a) of this subtitle, which sets forth the composition of the Advisory Board.
