- (3) THE ATTORNEY GENERAL OR AN INDIVIDUAL DESIGNATED BY THE ATTORNEY GENERAL AS PROVIDED UNDER THE MARYLAND RULES FOR SERVICE ON A STATE AGENCY THAT IS REPRESENTED BY THE ATTORNEY GENERAL.
- $\underline{\text{(C)}}$ SERVICE OF A SUBPOENA UNDER THIS SECTION IS EQUIVALENT TO PERSONAL SERVICE ON AN OFFICIAL CUSTODIAN OR A CUSTODIAN OF PUBLIC RECORDS.
- (D) THE COURT OF APPEALS MAY ADOPT RULES TO IMPLEMENT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.

Article - State Government

6-109.

- (a) (1) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated.
 - (2) "Department" means the Department of Assessments and Taxation.
- (3) "Governing body" means the head, board, council, board of directors, or other governing body of a State agency.
- (b) (1) A State agency not represented by the Attorney General [may] SHALL designate a citizen of this State who resides in this State, a Maryland corporation, or an officer of the State agency as its resident agent and change its resident agent by filing for record with the Department a certified copy of a resolution of its governing body that authorizes the designation or change.
- (2) A State agency may change the address for its resident agent by filing for record with the Department a statement of the change signed by the chairman or other principal officer of its governing body.
- (c) (1) A resident agent whose address changes may notify the Department by filing for record with the Department a statement of the change signed by or for the resident agent.
- (2) A resident agent may resign by filing with the Department a statement of resignation.
 - (d) There is no fee for a filing under this section.
