

(1) A RESIDENT AGENT DESIGNATED UNDER ARTICLE 24, § 1-110 OF THE CODE ~~OR MARYLAND RULES 2-124 AND 3-124~~ FOR SERVICE ON A LOCAL ENTITY;

(2) A RESIDENT AGENT DESIGNATED UNDER § 6-109 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE ~~OR MARYLAND RULES 2-124 AND 3-124~~ FOR SERVICE ON A STATE AGENCY THAT IS NOT REPRESENTED BY THE ATTORNEY GENERAL; OR

(3) THE ATTORNEY GENERAL OR AN INDIVIDUAL DESIGNATED BY THE ATTORNEY GENERAL AS PROVIDED UNDER THE MARYLAND RULES FOR SERVICE ON A STATE AGENCY THAT IS REPRESENTED BY THE ATTORNEY GENERAL.

(C) SERVICE OF A SUBPOENA UNDER THIS SECTION IS EQUIVALENT TO PERSONAL SERVICE ON AN OFFICIAL CUSTODIAN OR A CUSTODIAN OF PUBLIC RECORDS.

(D) THE COURT OF APPEALS MAY ADOPT RULES TO IMPLEMENT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.

Article - State Government

6-109.

(a) (1) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated.

(2) "Department" means the Department of Assessments and Taxation.

(3) "Governing body" means the head, board, council, board of directors, or other governing body of a State agency.

(b) (1) A State agency not represented by the Attorney General [may] SHALL designate a citizen of this State who resides in this State, a Maryland corporation, or an officer of the State agency as its resident agent and change its resident agent by filing for record with the Department a certified copy of a resolution of its governing body that authorizes the designation or change.

(2) A State agency may change the address for its resident agent by filing for record with the Department a statement of the change signed by the chairman or other principal officer of its governing body.

(c) (1) A resident agent whose address changes may notify the Department by filing for record with the Department a statement of the change signed by or for the resident agent.

(2) A resident agent may resign by filing with the Department a statement of resignation.

(d) There is no fee for a filing under this section.

(e) A designation, change of agent, change of address, or resignation is effective as provided in the Corporations and Associations Article for a corporate resident agent.
