SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section(s) 10–101(f) through (aa), respectively, of Article – Natural Resources of the Annotated Code of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 10–101(g) through (bb), respectively.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Natural Resources

10-101.

- (E) (1) "FEDERAL FACILITY" MEANS FEDERAL LAND IN THE STATE.
- (2) "FEDERAL FACILITY" INCLUDES MILITARY BASES, NATIONAL WILDLIFE REFUGES, AND UNITS OF THE NATIONAL PARK SYSTEM.
- [(e)] (F) "Forest game birds and mammals" means forest game birds (ruffed grouse and turkey) and forest game mammals (black bears, deer, fox squirrels, excluding the Delmarva subspecies, and gray and red squirrels) or any part, egg, offspring, or dead body of any of them.

10 409.

- (A) [Pursuant to] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, UNDER § 10-205 of this title, the Department shall establish and publish by April 25 each year the bag limits per day for game birds and mammals by regulation for the ensuing year. The bag limits for ducks, geese, brant, railbirds, woodcock, mergansers, doves, and snipe may conform to the federal migratory bird-rules and regulations adopted annually by the Secretary of Interior of the United States.
- (B) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO BAG LIMITS FOR DEER HUNTING ON A FEDERAL FACILITY.

- (a) There are the following 3 seasons to hunt deer:
 - (1) Deer bow hunting season;
 - (2) Deer firearms season: and
 - (3) Deer muzzle loader season.
- (b) (1) Every person killing a deer shall report with the deer to a designated checking station within 24 hours after killing the deer.
