and place of opening of the bids; and the bids shall be opened in the presence of [the Clerk to the County Commissioners] AN EMPLOYEE DESIGNATED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CARROLL COUNTY, and the County Commissioners of Carroll County shall award the contract to the lowest responsible bidder whose bid is considered reasonable, or in [its] THEIR discretion, may reject any or all bids. The County Commissioners may authorize nonprofit entities that are funded by the County or eligible to receive County funds, to participate in County procurement contracts.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2001.
