<u>COMMISSIONER DESIGNATES TO</u> CAST A PROXY VOTE ON BEHALF OF THE COUNCIL <u>MEMBER-WHEN-PRESENT UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION</u> VOTING COMMISSIONER.

(C) THE BYLAWS OF THE COUNCIL MAY PROVIDE FOR ADDITIONAL PRIVATE CITIZEN MEMBERSHIP ON THE COUNCIL.

2-102.

- (A) A MEMBER WHO HOLDS MEMBERSHIP BY VIRTUE OF THE MEMBER'S ELECTED POSITION HOLDS OFFICE ONLY DURING THE MEMBER'S TERM OF OFFICE.

2-103.

VACANCIES ON THE COUNCIL SHALL BE FILLED FOR THE DURATION OF THE UNEXPIRED TERM IN THE SAME MANNER AS PROVIDED FOR THE ORIGINAL APPOINTMENT.

2-104.

MEMBERS OF THE COUNCIL SERVE WITHOUT COMPENSATION. 2-105.

THE COUNCIL SHALL ELECT A CHAIRPERSON FROM AMONG ITS MEMBERS.

SUBTITLE 2. BYLAWS.

2-201.

THE COUNCIL MAY ADOPT BYLAWS, RULES; AND REGULATIONS FOR THE CONDUCT OF THE COUNCIL AND TO CARRY OUT THE COUNCIL'S MISSION.

SUBTITLE 3. FINANCING.

2-301.

- (A) (1) THE COUNCIL MAY RECEIVE STATE FINANCIAL SUPPORT TO ASSIST IN CARRYING OUT ITS ACTIVITIES.
- (2) (1) ON OR BEFORE AUGUST 1 OF EACH YEAR, THE COUNCIL SHALL SUBMIT TO THE DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ITS PROPOSED WORK PROGRAMS AND OPERATING BUDGET FOR THE FOLLOWING FISCAL YEAR, TOGETHER WITH SUPPORTING SCHEDULES TO SHOW HOW THE BUDGET IS FINANCED, AND TO PROVIDE FOR REVIEW AND RECOMMENDATIONS.
- (II) THE DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT SHALL FORWARD THE COUNCIL'S PLAN TO THE DEPARTMENT OF BUDGET AND MANAGEMENT FOR CONSIDERATION.
