- (A) THE VOTING MEMBERS AND MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY WHO HOLD MEMBERSHIP BY VIRTUE OF THEIR ELECTED OR APPOINTED POSITION HOLD OFFICE ONLY DURING THEIR TERM OF OFFICE.

- (A) (1) THE COUNCIL MAY RECEIVE STATE FINANCIAL SUPPORT TO ASSIST IN CARRYING OUT ITS ACTIVITIES.
- (2) (I) ON OR BEFORE AUGUST 1 OF EACH YEAR, THE COUNCIL SHALL SUBMIT TO THE DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ITS PROPOSED WORK PROGRAMS AND OPERATING BUDGET FOR THE FOLLOWING FISCAL YEAR, TOGETHER WITH SUPPORTING SCHEDULES TO SHOW HOW THE BUDGET IS FINANCED, AND TO PROVIDE FOR REVIEW AND RECOMMENDATIONS.
- (II) THE DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT SHALL FORWARD THE PROPOSED OPERATING BUDGET TO THE DEPARTMENT OF BUDGET AND MANAGEMENT FOR CONSIDERATION.
- (3) THE STATE BUDGET, SUBJECT TO ANNUAL REVIEW BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, SHALL PROVIDE AN APPROPRIATION IN THE FOLLOWING FISCAL YEAR OF AT LEAST \$200,000 FOR SUPPORT OF THE COUNCIL.
