CHAPTER 535

(House Bill 1181)

AN ACT concerning

Baltimore City - Sheriff - Deputy Sheriff Majors and Deputy Sheriffs

FOR the purpose of requiring the Sheriff of Baltimore City to appoint a certain number of deputy sheriff majors; altering the number of deputy sheriffs that may be appointed the Sheriff of Baltimore City may appoint; and generally relating to the Sheriff of Baltimore City and ~~Deputy Sheriff Majors~~ employees of the Sheriff's office.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings

2-309.

(d) (1) (i) In Baltimore City, the Sheriff shall receive an expense allowance of \$1,000 per year and a salary of:

1. \$62,000 in calendar year 1999;
2. \$64,000 in calendar year 2000;
3. \$67,000 in calendar year 2001; and
4. \$70,000 in calendar year 2002 and thereafter.

(ii) The Sheriff:

1. Shall appoint an undersheriff or chief deputy sheriff, [a] TWO deputy sheriff [major] MAJORS, two deputy sheriff captains, four deputy sheriff lieutenants, four deputy sheriff sergeants, one administrative officer II sheriff, one secretary sheriff, one fiscal associate II sheriff, and one fiscal clerk sheriff; and

2. May appoint a total of ~~84~~ 83 deputy sheriffs.
