SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Transportation

"Moped" means a [bicycle] PEDAL OR NONPEDAL VEHICLE that:

- (1) [Is designed to be operated by human power with the assistance of a motor;
- (2) Is equipped with pedals that mechanically drive the rear wheel-or wheels;
- (3)] Has two [or three] wheels, of which one is [more than 14] 10 inches OR MORE in diameter; [and
 - (4) (2) Has a motor [with]:
 - (I) WITH a rating of [1.5] 2.7 brake horsepower or less [and, if]; OR
- (II) IF the motor is an internal combustion engine, WITH a capacity of [50] 55 cubic centimeters piston displacement or less; AND
 - (2) HAS A MAXIMUM SPEED OF 20 MILES PER HOUR

 - (1) HAS A SEAT FOR THE OPERATOR;
