- (5) 80 percent of the funds distributed ON SHORT-TERM VEHICLE RENTALS under [§ 2-1302.1] § 2-1302.1(A) of the Tax General Article to the Transportation Trust Fund from the sales and use tax.
- (5) [80 percent of the funds distributed under § 2 1302.1 of the Tax—General Article to the Transportation Trust Fund from the sales and use tax] THE REVENUE DISBURSED TO THIS ACCOUNT UNDER § 2 1302.1(A)(1) OF THE TAX—GENERAL ARTICLE.
- (5) (I) FOR THE PERIOD FROM JANUARY 1, 2002 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2002 AND FOR FISCAL YEARS BEGINNING ON OR AFTER JULY 1, 2002 BUT BEFORE JULY 1, 2007, THE REVENUE DISBURSED TO THIS ACCOUNT UNDER § 2–1302.1(A)(1) OF THE TAX—CENERAL ARTICLE: AND
- (II) FOR THE PERIOD FROM JULY 1, 2001, THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2001 AND FOR FISCAL YEARS BEGINNING ON OR AFTER JULY 1, 2007, 80% OF THE FUNDS DISTRIBUTED TO THE TRANSPORTATION TRUST FUND FROM THE SALES AND USE TAX UNDER § 2 1802.1(B) OF THE TAX—GENERAL ARTICLE.
- (c) (1) During each fiscal year, the Account shall be used to pay the allocations of highway user revenues provided by this subtitle to the counties, municipalities, and Baltimore City; and
- (2) The balance of the Account may be used as provided in  $\S$  3–216 of this article.

## 13-208.

- (a) (1) [The Administration shall deposit \$14 of] FOR EACH FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING ON OR AFTER JULY 1, 2002 BUT BEFORE JULY 1, 2007, EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, OF each filing fee received under this subtitle, THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL DEPOSIT \$9 IN THE TRANSPORTATION TRUST FUND AND \$5 in the General Fund.
- (2) FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2001 AND EACH FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING ON OR AFTER JULY 1, 2007, OF EACH FILING FEE RECEIVED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE, THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL DEPOSIT \$14 IN THE GENERAL FUND.
- (b) For each fiscal year, the Comptroller shall distribute to Baltimore City an amount equal to \$5 [for] OF THE GENERAL FUND PORTION OF each filing fee received under this subtitle.

## 13–613.

- (d) Except as provided in subsection (e) of this section, of the proceeds collected annually from the additional fees charged under this section:
- (1) The first \$180,000 shall be paid into a special fund administered by the Maryland Higher Education Commission for use in the medical, dental, legal, nursing, social work, and pharmaceutical scholarship programs provided by this State;
