

(2) THE SUBTRACTION UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION INCLUDES A PAYMENT FROM A PENSION SYSTEM TO THE SURVIVING SPOUSE OR OTHER BENEFICIARY OF A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER OR FIRE FIGHTER WHOSE DEATH ARISES OUT OF OR IN THE COURSE OF EMPLOYMENT AS A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER OR FIRE FIGHTER.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2001, and shall be applicable to all taxable years beginning after December 31, 2000.

**CHAPTER 585**

**(Senate Bill 225)**

AN ACT concerning

**Charles County - Highways - Prohibition on Use for Solicitations**

FOR the purpose of authorizing the ~~State Highway Administration or a local authority~~ County Commissioners of Charles County to prohibit the use of a controlled access highway in the county's jurisdiction by a person soliciting money, donations, employment, business, or a ride from an occupant of a vehicle on the controlled access highway; ~~prohibiting, except under certain circumstances, a person from standing in a roadway to solicit money or donations from an occupant of a vehicle;~~ prohibiting, in Charles County, a person from standing in a roadway, median divider, or intersection to solicit a ride, employment, business, money, money or donations from an occupant of a vehicle; and generally relating to restrictions on the use of highways in Charles County for solicitation.
