- (A) BY JANUARY 1 OF EACH YEAR, 2003 AND EACH YEAR THEREAFTER, THE BOARD SHALL SUBMIT A REPORT TO THE GOVERNOR AND THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2–1246 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THIS SUBTITLE.
- (B) IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER INFORMATION DETERMINED BY THE BOARD, USING THE DATA COLLECTED AND PROVIDED BY THE DEPARTMENT, THE REPORT SHALL:
 - (1) SPECIFY THE NUMBER OF ELIGIBLE INDIVIDUALS THAT:
- (I) HAVE APPLIED FOR TRAINING AND SERVICES TO BE FUNDED BY THE STEP PROGRAM IN THE PRIOR CALENDAR YEAR;
- (II) ARE PURSUING SKILLS-BASED TRAINING AND THE EXTENT TO WHICH THESE INDIVIDUALS ARE SUCCEEDING IN THE TRAINING;
 - (III) HAVE SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED SKILLS-BASED TRAINING;
- (IV) ARE RECEIVING WRAPAROUND SERVICES FUNDED BY THE STEP PROGRAM AND THE TYPE OF SERVICES FUNDED;
- (V) HAVE OBTAINED ADVANCED EMPLOYMENT ON COMPLETION OF SKILLS-BASED TRAINING AND ANY CHANGE IN WAGES OR BENEFITS RECEIVED; AND
- (VI) ARE PARTICIPATING IN EMPLOYER-BASED TRAINING PROGRAMS AND THE NUMBER AND TYPES OF EMPLOYERS PARTICIPATING IN THESE PROGRAMS; AND
- (2) PROVIDE THE RESULTS OF THE PERFORMANCE EVALUATION OF THE STEP PROGRAM BASED ON THE STANDARDS ESTABLISHED BY THE BOARD UNDER \S 18–404 OF THIS SUBTITLE.

18-408.

THIS SUBTITLE MAY BE CITED AS THE "STEP PROGRAM".

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That it is the intent of the General Assembly that if a portion of the STEP Program is funded with moneys from the federal Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (TANF) block grant, a local workforce investment board that receives a STEP Program grant shall make best efforts to direct a proportionate amount of STEP Program funds to services for individuals that <u>who</u> are current or recent recipients of TANF Program or Family Investment Program services.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That it is the intent of the General Assembly that a local workforce investment board that receives a STEP Program grant shall make best efforts to ensure that STEP Program funds are directed primarily towards services for low income low-income working parents.
