- (IV) THE LEVEL OF FINANCIAL COMMITMENT THAT THE APPLICANT IS ABLE TO PROVIDE: AND
- (V) ANY OTHER FACTORS THAT THE BOARD DETERMINES TO BE APPROPRIATE THE BOARD SHALL ADOPT RECULATIONS ESTABLISHING THE CRITERIA AND PROCEDURES FOR THE AWARDING OF FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE UNDER THIS SECTION.
- (F) (1) UNLESS THE REQUIREMENT IS WAIVED BY THE BOARD IN WHOLE OR PART, FOR GOOD CAUSE SHOWN, A RECIPIENT OF A GRANT FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE UNDER SUBSECTION (D)(3)(III) OF THIS SECTION SHALL PROVIDE MATCHING FUNDS OR IN–KIND CONTRIBUTIONS FOR THE PROJECT THAT ARE AT LEAST EQUAL TO THE AMOUNT OF THE GRANT FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE AWARDED.
- (2) UNLESS OTHERWISE APPROVED BY A TWO-THIRDS VOTE OF THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE BOARD, THE BOARD MAY NOT AWARD GRANTS FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE WITHIN A SINGLE COUNTY OR WITHIN BALTIMORE CITY UNDER SUBSECTION (D)(3)(III) OF THIS SECTION THAT EXCEED A TOTAL OF \$1,000,000 IN ANY FISCAL YEAR.
