WHEREAS, There are approximately 770,000 adults currently residing in Maryland who are without a high school diploma or its equivalent; and

WHEREAS, Only approximately 37,000 of these adults are being served by presently existing adult education services; and

WHEREAS, There is a documented need in Maryland for a better educated workforce, and the General Assembly believes that improved adult education would help address that need; now, therefore,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That:

- (a) There shall be a Task Force to Study Adult Education Services in Maryland.
 - (b) The Task Force shall be composed of:
- (1) One member of the Governor's Workforce Investment Board, appointed by the Governor;
- (2) One representative of the Department of Business and Economic Development, appointed by the Secretary of the Department of Business and Economic Development;
- (3) One representative of the Department of Labor, Licensing, and Regulation, appointed by the Secretary of the Department of Labor, Licensing, and Regulation;
- (4) One representative of the Department of Human Resources, appointed by the Secretary of the Department of Human Resources;
- (5) Two local Literacy Works team administrators, appointed by the State Superintendent of Schools;
- (6) One representative of family literacy programs, appointed by the State Superintendent of Schools;
- (7) At least two county superintendents active in adult education, appointed by the State Superintendent of Schools;
- (8) One representative of the State Advisory Committee for Adult Education, appointed by the State Superintendent of Schools;
- (9) One representative from a State community college, appointed by the Secretary of the Maryland Higher Education Commission;
- (10) One representative of a Local Workforce Investment Board, appointed by the Secretary of the Department of Labor, Licensing, and Regulation;
- (11) One representative of the State Department of Education, appointed by the State Superintendent of Schools;
 - (12) A Regional Coordinator for the External Diploma Program;
