(4) IF A LICENSE IS RENEWED EXPIRES ON OR AFTER OCTOBER 1, 2003, THE LICENSEE A PROFESSIONAL LAND SURVEYOR OR LICENSED PROPERTY LINE SURVEYOR IS REQUIRED TO FULFILL THE FULL CONTINUING PROFESSIONAL COMPETENCY REQUIREMENT AS PROVIDED IN THE REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE BOARD UNDER THIS SUBSECTION.

CHAPTER 602

(Senate Bill 418)

AN ACT concerning

Environment - Sanitary Sewer Overflows - Reporting

FOR the purpose of requiring the owner or operator of certain sewer systems or wastewater treatment plants to provide certain reports of certain overflows or treatment plant bypasses within certain periods of time to the Department of the Environment; requiring the Department, in cooperation with certain agencies, to develop procedures for requiring the owner or operator of certain sewer systems or wastewater treatment plants to provide certain public notification of certain sewage overflows; requiring the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene and local health departments to make certain decisions and determinations about certain issues; providing that a certain owner or operator is not responsible for making certain decisions or determinations; requiring the Department of the Environment to adopt regulations implementing the requirements of this Act; and generally relating to the reporting of sewer overflows.
