FOR the purpose of altering the office and personnel requirements for certain's governmental self-insurance groups, employers that self-insure; and insurers providing workers' compensation insurance in the State; and requiring the Workers' Compensation Commission to report on or before a certain date to certain committees of the General Assembly; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating to office and personnel requirements for certain governmental self-insurance groups, employers that self-insure, and insurers providing workers' compensation insurance in the State and generally relating to office and personnel requirements for certain employers that self-insure and insurers providing workers' compensation insurance in the State.
