~~(c) (1) If any funds received under subsection (a) or (b) of this section or any income derived from the operation of Banneker Douglass Museum or from educational materials and activities of the Commission are unexpended at the end of the fiscal year, the funds or income may not revert to the General Fund of the State, but instead, shall be maintained as special funds available to the Commission for carrying out the purposes of this subtitle.~~
