## CHAPTER 624

(Senate Bill 774)

AN ACT concerning

### **Carroll County - County Commissioners - Salary Increase**

FOR the purpose of increasing the salary of the County Commissioners for Carroll County; providing that this Act does not apply to the salary or compensation of the incumbent County Commissioners for Carroll County; and generally relating to the salary of the County Commissioners for Carroll County.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Section 3-101

Article 7 - Public Local Laws of Maryland

(1976 Edition and September 1999 Supplement, as amended)

(As enacted by Chapter 601 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2000)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

#### **Article 7 - Carroll County**

3-101.

(a) There are three County Commissioners for Carroll County.

(b) Each County Commissioner is entitled to:

(1) A salary of [\$32,500] \$45,000 a year; and

(2) An allowance for expenses incurred in the performance of the duties of that office, as provided in the county budget.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, Section 35 of the Constitution of Maryland, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to the salary or compensation of the County Commissioners for Carroll County in office on the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or compensation of the County Commissioners for Carroll County shall take effect at the beginning of the next following term of office.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2001.
